WHAT IS TOPIC MODELING

- Using unsupervised machine learning methods to extract unknown commonalities from unstructured text data
- Use scenario: when you have a set of unlabeled data and you want to pull out insights from it
- How does it work?
 - Uses a soft/fuzzy clustering technique to segment reviews into different topics

MY PROCESS

- Pulled 28,044 Carhartt reviews from Amazon
- Preprocessed the text
 - Broke reviews down to by root word, its part of speech in the sentence, and removed all common and uncommon words
- Built topic models
- Classification of reviews
 - All reviews, 5-star reviews, and 2 or less star reviews
- Qualitative analysis
- Insights


THE REVIEWS

28,044 total reviews


18,720 with 5-stars

THE GOOD, THE BAD, AND THE USELESS...

THE USELESS: TOPIC MODEL OF ALL REVIEWS

- 6082 about 'pants'
- 5476 relating to 'shirt'
- 9481 relating to 'coat'
- 3396 relating to 'jacket'



FINDINGS

- Pants are durable and great for work
- Fit well but shrinks in the wash
- Loose fitting pants are popular
- Hard to find clothes as comfortable as Carhartt
- Sizing issues for heavier set people

THE GOOD: 5 STAR REVIEWS

- 2,003 about pants
- 3,639 about shirts
- 1,351 about coat's
- 2,395 about jackets



FINDINGS

- 1. True Carhartt quality and fit
- 2. Shirts and pants are great for taller people (long cut)
- 3. Good products, good price
- 4. Recommend the comfortable work pants
- 5. Love all products
- 6. Well made and high quality jackets
- 7. t-shirts last longer than expected for the low price
- 8. Coat fits perfect
- 9. XL shirts fit big, but that's not a bad thing
- 11. Ordered for a family member
- 12. Warm work jacket
- 13. Fit tall and long
- 14. Gifted the jacket and it's a keeper
- 15. Pants run large, only bad if you're little
- 16. Carhartt is the best way to keep warm when you are working
- 17. Order didn't fit at first, but then returned it and loved
- 18. Work clothes are functional and warm
- 20. Bought as a gift for husband


THE BAD: TWO STARS OR LESS

- 243 about pants
- 383 about shirts
- 84 about coats
- 169 about jacket's
- 393 mention having to return something













FINDINGS

- 1. Carhartt pants are too tight and too long for bigger people
- 2. The zippers on the jacket are low quality
- 3. The jackets have a weird cut/sizing
- 4. Unreliable sizing on the t-shirts
- 5. Over time the color and sizing of jeans has degraded
- 6. When buying socks, people expect a 6-pack but only get 2 pairs
- 7. Money clip and wallet are poor quality
- 8. Carhartt pants are not the same quality they used to be
- 9. Sizing is off mostly for socks
- 10. Boots are cheap and fall apart
- 11. Pants are too baggy on the legs and too tight around the crotch
- 12. Jackets don't hold up to the "Carhartt" quality work pants; what they used to be known for

MARKETING & PRODUCT INSIGHTS

WHAT DO PEOPLE LIKE

- High quality clothing for a reasonable price
- Comfortable and durable work pants, good for daily use
- Longer cut pants are great for taller people
- T-shirts are great for bigger cut people
- Great gift for husband/son
- Warm and tight fitting jackets are fashionable

WHAT DO THEY DISLIKE

- Carhartt quality isn't what it used to be, and people are noticing
- A ton of people complaining about the unreliable sizing of the socks
- The pants are fit too tight around the butt and too baggy around the legs
